Millcross selected as preferred site for new Clevedon Hospital

NHS North Somerset is delighted to confirm that Millcross has been selected as the preferred site for the new Clevedon Community Hospital. An outline planning application has been submitted to North Somerset Council which outlines how the site of the old Kwik Save store will be regenerated for a new hospital for the population of Woodspring. The planning application number will appear on the dedicated project page of NHS North Somerset website as soon as it is available. This will enable all interested parties to view and make comments on the planning submission on North Somerset Council's website.

"This is another important milestone in our strategy of delivering the best quality and local healthcare for the people of North Somerset" said Chris Born, Chief Executive of NHS North Somerset. "We will now begin working closely with the community living near the Millcross site to ensure that, when the time comes, the building programme causes the minimum amount of disruption to them whilst ensuring that the finished Hospital fits in with their expectations."



Millcross is next to a residential area just off the Ring Road. The redevelopment of this site will provide an opportunity to enhance the environment with a striking new building built to the highest standards.

Parts of the transport infrastructure are already in place with bus stops and links to Clevedon and the surrounding area. However, we aim to work closely with local community to ensure that all transport needs are met.

The aim is to have the site secured by the end of March 2010. NHS North Somerset will then present a further business Case to the Strategic Health Authority for their consideration.
