

**Where do the patients live who currently receive services from Wrington Vale Medical Practice?**

The Practice currently operates from two surgeries in Churchill and Wrington, which are just over 2.5 miles apart.

The Practice serves approximately 9,100 patients across a catchment area of approximately 40 square miles. The spread of patients is outlined in the table on next page:
